



EDUCATIONAL TRIP - TRIVENI KALA SANGAM & LOTUS TEMPLE

School of Architecture, Delhi Technical Campus organized an “Educational Trip to Triveni Kala Sangam and Lotus Temple” on 16th December, 2022 for the students of 1st and 2nd year. The purpose of the trip was to consolidate course contents by providing exposure to students and acquaint them with the diverse design principles; architectural elements; cultural and geo-climatic context of the region; and building construction and structure details, which form an integral part of Architectural studies.

The trip commenced by visiting Triveni Kala Sangam at Mandi House, New Delhi, which is a cultural and modern architectural style landmark in the city of Delhi. Designed by renowned architect Joseph Allen Stein in 1957 and dedicated to cultural activities, it remains one of the icons of post-independence architecture in the city. Students visited the multiple spaces in the complex designed for multiple purposes. The perfectly synchronized interior and outdoor spaces provided students the clarity in the functioning and integration of each and every space. They drew sketches, took measurements and captured photographs to understand the various architectural and structural aspects of the buildings. This was followed by the visit to Lotus Temple at Kalkaji, New Delhi, which is a symbol of excellence in modern Indian architecture. The students got exposed to the unique form of this House of Worship which takes the shape of lotus, a flower considered sacred by most Indians. They drew sketches and took photographs to understand the design principles, elements, features and construction details of the building.

The aim of the trip was to provide practical exposure to the students and motivate them to explore architecture beyond classrooms. They analyzed the buildings on the basis of the academic exercises assigned to them. At the end of the trip, they could understand the built form and space in relation to the human scale and nature; principles of design; features and elements of modern Indian architecture; site context and circulation spaces; building construction and materials; layouts of several spaces like exhibitions, classrooms, auditorium, etc.




Figure 1- Visit to Triveni Kala Sangam
